

Plean Scoile Covid 19 – Gaelscoil Lios na nÓg

1. Réamhrá

Cuireadh an plean seo le chéile bunaithe ar an treoir atá tagtha ón Roinn Oideachais agus Scileanna maidir le h-athoscailt na mbunscoileanna. S’iad na doiciméid atá i gceist ná ‘An Treorchlár le Filleadh go hIomlán ar an Scoil’ agus ‘Plean Freagartha COVID 19’.

Is í an phríomhaidhm atá ag an bplean ná a chinntiú nach scaipeann an víreas sa scoil, i measc na bpáistí nó i measc na foirne. Chomh maith le sin, tá sé an-tábhachtach go mbíonn foireann na scoile ábalta díriú ar oideachas saibhir lán-ghaelach a chur ar fáil do na páistí agus go mbeidh na páistí ag foghlaim agus ag forbairt. Le seo a chinntiú, beidh na moltaí atá déanta anseo dírithe ar na gnéithe seo a leanas:

- a. Tacú le dea-shláinteachas lámh agus riospráide agus iad a chur chun cinn.
- b. Réim bhreise ghlantacháin a chur i bhfeidhm sa scoil.
- c. Cloí le scaradh fisiciúil sa scoil chomh fada is gur féidir.

Tá sé tábhachtach go dtuigeann tuismitheoirí, páistí agus foireann na scoile nach bhfuil gníomhaíocht ar bith idir dhaoine gan riosca, go dtras-seolfar inghalrú ag am ar bith.

2. An Plean

2.1. Tacú le Dea-Shláinteachas Lámh agus Riospráide agus iad a Chur Chun Cinn

- a. Nuair a bhíonn na páistí agus foireann na scoile ag teacht isteach tríd doras na scoile ar maidin agus ag fágáil um tráthnóna, déanfar díghalrú ar a cuid lámha ag stáisiún díghalraithe.
- b. Nuair a bhíonn na páistí agus múinteoirí ag fágáil agus ag filleadh ar an seomra ranga ar chúis ar bith, is gá go mbeidh dí-ghalrú déanta ar a gcuid lámha.
- c. Beidh galúnach sa leithreas agus beidh stáisiún díghalraithe scaipthe tríd an scoil.
- d. Beidh díghalrán ar fáil istigh sna ranganna gur féidir leis na páistí a úsáid roimh agus tar éis lón a ithe agus tar éis casachta nó sraotha a chlúdach lena lámha.
- e. Ní bheidh páistí ag roinnt lena chéile. Beidh ar gach páiste a gcuid fearas fhéin a bheith acu ar scoil gach lá (pinn luaidh, scriosáin srl)

- f. Beidh a ndíghalrán fhéin ag gach ball foirne.
- g. Is gá do pháistí agus do mhúinteoirí cinntiú go gclúdaíonn siad a gcuid béil agus sróna agus iad ag casacht nó ag sraoth. Is gá dóibh casadh chomh fada ó dhaoine eile is gur féidir.
- h. Cuirfidh gach múinteoir béim ar an dea-shláinteachas lámh agus riosparáide agus déanfaidh an Príomhionadaí Oibríthe cinnte de go mbíonn an scoil ag cloí leis an deá-chleachtais is déanaí mar a thagann athrú ar chúrsaí.

2.2. Réim Bhreise Ghlantacháin a Chur i bhFeidhm sa Scoil

- a. Glanfar gach láthair foghlama sa scoil uair amháin in aghaidh an lae, ar a laghad.
- b. Beidh glantóir ar láthair na scoile i rith an lae scoile agus glanfar na dromchlaí go mbíonn teagmháil go minic leo go rialta.
- c. Beidh ábhair ghlantacháin ar fáil do mhúinteoirí le gur féidir leo a limistéir oibre féin a choinneáil glan go laethiúil.
- d. Glanfar bréagáin sna bunranganna uair sa tseachtain.

2.3. Scaradh Fisiciúil agus Teagmháil a Laghdú

- a. Beidh na h-amanna teachta ar scoil/dul abhaile ón scoil agaithe agus beidh na bealaí isteach/amach ar an dá thaobh den fhoirgneamh in úsáid. Féach ar an tábla thíos:

- b. Is gá do pháistí a bheith in am ag teacht ar scoil.
- c. Beidh cead ag deartháireacha agus deirfiúreacha an chéad pháiste sa chlann ar scoil teacht in éineacht leo. Beidh orthu siúl isteach i gclós na scoile agus fanacht ina suí leo féin go dtí go bhfuil sé in am dóibh dul isteach sa bhfoirgneamh.

- d.** Beidh an múinteoir ranga ag fanacht ar a rang ag an am cuí agus siúlfaidh sé/sí díreach go dtí an seomra ranga leis na páistí. Níl cead ag tuismitheoir/feighlí ar bith teacht tríd geata na scoile seachas i gcás fíor-eisceachtúil.
- e.** Ag ag am dul abhaile beidh an córas céanna i bhfeidhm. Moltar do thuistí sna hardranganna (4 - 6) socrú a dhéanamh bualadh leis na páistí i bPáirc Belgrave más féidir. Beidh litir ón múinteoir le síniú ag an tuismitheoirí chun é seo a cheadú seo.
- f.** Beidh an scoil roinnte ina dá leath do na páistí. Ciallóidh sé seo nach mbeidh rang ar bith atá ar thaobh na lámhe clé den scoil ag trasnú go dtí taobh na lámha deise, agus a mhalairt.
- g.** Beidh na ranganna ar fad ina 'mbolgáin', rud a chiallóidh nach meascfaidh siad le rang ar bith eile le linn an lae scoile.
- h.** Beidh am clóis éagsúil ag gach rang.
- i.** I ranganna 3 – 6, beidh grúpaí taobh istigh den rang. Ní bheidh fearas cosúil le leabhair, páipéar srl ag bogadh idir na grúpaí. Beidh na grúpaí scartha go fisiciúil chomh fada is gur féidir, ach ní bheidh sé indéanta é a chinntiú don lá scoile iomlán.
- j.** Beidh a leithreas féin á úsáid ag gach rang don lá scoile iomlán. Páiste amháin ag an am a bheidh in aon leithreas.

Covid 19 School Plan – Gaelscoil Lios na nÓg

1. Foreword

This plan was drawn up based on guidance from the Department of Education and skills regarding the reopening of primary schools. The source documents are ‘Reopening Our Schools: The Roadmap for the Full Return to School’ and ‘COVID 19 Response Plan.’

The main aim of this plan is to ensure that the virus does not spread in the school amongst children or staff. It is also vital that staff can focus on providing a rich educational experience ‘as gaeilge’ for the children, and that the children will learn and develop. To ensure this, there will be a focus on the following aspects:

- a. Support for and promotion of good hand and respiratory hygiene.
- b. Additional cleaning regimen in the school.
- c. Physical/Social distancing in the school, as much as possible.

It is important that parents, children and staff understand that there is no interpersonal activity without risk, that infection can be transmitted at any time.

2. The Plan

2.1. Supporting and Promoting Good Hand and Respiratory Hygiene

- a. On arriving at and leaving the school, children and staff will sanitise their hands at sanitising stations.
- b. Children or staff who leave or return to the classroom for any reason, should sanitise their hands.
- c. There will be soap in the toilets and sanitising stations throughout the school.
- d. Hand sanitiser will be available in the classrooms so that children can use it before and after eating, as well as after covering a cough or sneeze with their hands.
- e. Children will not be sharing and must have their own equipment (pencils, erasers etc) in school every day.

- f. Each member of staff will have their own hand sanitiser.
- g. Children and staff must cover their mouth and nose when they cough or sneeze. They should turn away from other people as much as possible.
- h. Every teacher will stress the importance of good hand and respiratory hygiene and the Lead Worker Representative will ensure that the school adheres to the latest best practice, as matters evolve.

2.2. Additional Cleaning Regime in the School

- a. All places of learning in the school will be cleaned at least once a day.
- b. There will be a cleaner in the school building during school hours and all regularly-touched surfaces will be cleaned regularly.
- c. Cleaning materials will be available to teachers so that they can keep their work space clean on a daily basis.
- d. Toys in the junior classes will be cleaned once a week.

2.3. Social Distancing and Reducing Contact

- a. Times for arriving at and leaving the school will be staggered and the entrances/exits on both sides of the building will be used. See the table below:

- b. Every child must be on time coming to school.
- c. Siblings of a child due to come to school earliest in the morning can come with them. They

should walk into the school yard and wait by themselves until it is time for them to enter the school building.

- d.** The class teacher will wait on their class at the appropriate time and he/she will walk with the children into the school building. Parents/Child minders are not permitted to enter the school grounds, except in exceptional circumstances.
- e.** The same system will be in place at home time. It is recommended that parents of children in the senior classes (4 – 6) arrange to meet their child(ren) in Belgrave Park, if possible. Parents will have to sign a permission letter from the teacher to allow this.
- f.** The school will be divided in two for the children. This means that no class on the left hand side of the school will cross over to the right hand side of the school, and vice versa.
- g.** All classes will be in ‘bubbles’, which means that no class will mix with another during the school day.
- h.** Each class will have a different yard time.
- i.** There will be sub-groups within classes 3 – 6. No equipment (books, paper) will move between groups. Each group will be physically separated from each other as much as possible, but it is not possible to guarantee this during the whole school day.
- j.** Each class will use their own toilet during the school day. There will be one child at a time in the toilets.
